Based on the Decision on the establishment and work of the Selection Committee for evaluation and selection of applications submitted under the Call for Proposals "Towards Meeting the Sustainable Development Goals in Serbia: Job Quality and Economic Structure, How are They Linked?", the Selection Committee prepared:

Report on the Final assessment and selection list

Center for Advanced Economic Studies (CEVES) announced a Call for Project Proposals on April 27th 2018 within the project "Using Sustainable Development Goals to Reposition Social Science Research: Pilot project". CEVES invited research organizations and group of researchers to submit their applications in accordance with the published conditions of the competition.

Based on the announced Call for Project Proposal and Decision on the establishment and work of the Selection Committee for evaluation and selection of applications submitted under the Call for Proposals "Towards Meeting the Sustainable Development Goals in Serbia: Job Quality and Economic Structure, How are They Linked?", on the first evaluation meeting of the Selection Committee (hereinafter the Committee) held on June 6, 2018 in PERFORM office in Belgrade, the Committee implemented procedures of opening and evaluating the applications submitted under the Call.

The evaluation procedure was divided into two rounds. In the first round, The Committee applied the blind assessment procedure, evaluating only project proposals/methodology, without having the information about the name of the applicants or the research team. In the second round, the Committee evaluated other parts of applications: CV and experience of researcher(s), Relevant experience of team members in similar assignments, and Value for money.

Based on the selection criteria, The Committee stated that neither of the two evaluated applications satisfied a sufficient level of the predefined criteria in order to be selected immediately. Thus, the Committee asked the best ranking applicant to address identified gaps in the application. That applicant did not submit the revised application by the end of the deadline. The Committee then asked the second ranking applicant to address the identified gaps.

After receiving revised application from second ranking applicant, the Committee reevaluated the revised application. Thereafter, the Committee prepared a Report on the preliminary results of the evaluation process.

All applicants were individually informed about results by email on July 12th, 2018. Preliminary results were published on CEVES website on July 13th, 2018.

The participants had the right to file a complaint within the three days from the date of publication of the preliminary list of evaluation and ranking.

After period of complaint had expired, the Committee determined Final assessment and selection list of applications. Since CEVES did not receive any complaint, the details on the Final assessment and selection list remained the same as the Report on the evaluation and selection process of applications with preliminary results.

Based on the Final assessment and selection list, PERFORM project will sign a contract with the best ranking Applicant.
